2010 Rules

Open to all Amateurs

Categories of Entries: Entrants will enter into one of four categories: **(1)** Family Team, a 2-person team with at least 1 entrant 12 years old or under, **(2)** Family Group, a 3 to 4 person team with at least 2 entrants 12 years old or under, **(3)** Friends Team, a 2-person team, and **(4)** Friends / Family Group, consisting of a 3 to 4 person team.

Size: Entries should have a base appropriate to the size of the gingerbread house and should not exceed 30" x 30". All entries must be on a piece of plywood or other rigid base.

Construction: Only one structure may be entered in the competition per person or per team. Any architectural structure is eligible for entry (i.e. house, train station, bridge, ship, lighthouse, etc.). Structure must be constructed mainly of gingerbread and icing. Non-visible interior supports of other materials are allowed. The entire visual display is to be made of edible materials. No perishable items allowed. Contestants will have up to 6 hours (8:00 am – 2:00 pm) to complete their structure. Due to drying time it is recommended that the construction and assembly of the walls and roof be completed prior to the event. However, all decorating and detail work must be completed at the Arnot Mall.

Entry Fee: \$25 per single entry, \$35 per team of two entrants, and \$50 for each team of 3-4 entrants. Entry fee includes t-shirts for all team members. All entry fees are non-refundable. **Check is to be made payable to: Habitat for Humanity.**

2010 Stimulus Package Entry Fee: Entries postmarked or dropped off at the Classic Café **by October 16, 2010** will receive \$5.00 off the non-refundable entry fee.

Entry Deadline: Entry can be either mailed to **Gingerbread House Competition, PO Box 4153, Elmira, NY 14904** or **dropped off at The Classic Café, 805 Pennsylvania Avenue, Elmira, NY 14904**. Entry must be postmarked or dropped off by **October 31, 2010** to guarantee t-shirts for all entrants.

Judging: Judges will award points for the following criteria: Most Original/Creative, Overall Appearance, Degree of Difficulty, and Adherence to Design Rules. Judges will evaluate on November 13th immediately after the construction time allocation. Points will be deducted for any deviation to the rules.

Awards: Cash prizes will be given to the top place in each Entry Category. In addition, there will be a prize awarded for the best Traditional Gingerbread House. Popular Vote will be held from 2:00 pm until 3:00 pm. All awards will be presented in Center Court of the Arnot Mall at 4:00 pm on November 13th.

Display/Pick-up: Entrants will take their House home with them following award ceremony on November 13, 2010.

Entrants:

- **All Entrants** are to bring own supplies to build their home. Bringing in pre-shaped (formed) walls is recommended.
- **All Entrants:** will receive a T-Shirt with competition logo and supporting sponsors. Check in near Arnot Mall Escalators in Center Court. Check In will begin at 8:00 am.
- **Family Group:** 3-4 person Team; at least 2 entrants must be 12 years and under.
- **All Teams of 2, 3, or 4:** On the form provided list each Group/Team members' names, school attending (if applicable), and signature from a parent or legal guardian if under 18 years old.
- **Sponsorship:** Entrants are allowed to seek own Sponsorship to pay for their entry fee. Sponsor will receive Sponsorship Recognition on the display table of entrant.
 - ***** Restrictions:** Sponsors cannot be retail or restaurant businesses unless the business is located at the Arnot Mall or approved by the Gingerbread House Competition.
